AGENCY DESCRIPTION

The department was created in 2001 to increase state government's focus on the role of technology in state programs and to accelerate the provision of services electronically to state government's customers and business partners.

The department is headed by a secretary appointed outside the classified service by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the Senate. The secretary serves as the state's chief information officer (CIO), a post found in the executive management of most progressive businesses. The secretary appoints a deputy secretary and executive assistant to serve at the pleasure of the secretary. The administrators of the department's three divisions are also appointed by the secretary outside the classified service.

The CIO and department work with executive branch agencies to manage all information technology resources to accomplish the most effective and efficient use of the resource. The CIO and department also have the advise and counsel of the Information Technology Management Board, which is chaired by the Governor.
