AGENCY DESCRIPTION

The Circuit Court is Wisconsin's court of general jurisdiction and consists of 241 judicial positions in 69 judicial circuits. Each county in the state is a circuit, with the exception of Pepin and Buffalo, Menominee and Shawano, and Forest and Florence, which are paired to form three circuits. Where the volume of litigation warrants, a circuit consists of more than one branch (judge). Of the 69 circuits, 39 contain multiple branches.

The Circuit Court has original jurisdiction in all criminal, civil, juvenile, family and probate cases unless exclusive jurisdiction has been given to another court. The court has appellate jurisdiction over orders and judgments of the municipal courts and the responsibility to review decisions and orders of state administrative agencies.

For purposes of management, the Circuit Courts are divided into ten administrative districts. Each district has a chief judge appointed by the Supreme Court and a district court administrator who administer the business of the judicial branch in that district in cooperation with the director of state courts at the direction of the chief justice. The first judicial district (Milwaukee County) also has an assistant district court administrator.

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1. Budget Efficiency Measures

The Governor recommends reducing expenditure authority in the court's state operations appropriations through a \$250,000 GPR lapse to create additional operational efficiencies and balance the budget.

2. Court Support Fee Increase

The Governor recommends increasing the courts' small claims filing, large claims filing, forfeiture judgment and civil court filing fees by 30 percent to fund increased operating costs. The fee increase will increase revenue by \$9,287,600 GPR-E in FY04 and \$11,205,600 GPR-E in FY05.
